After three appearances, Our Blessed Mother finally spoke to Bernadette. No one wants to hear that they will have to suffer. There will be times when things happen that make us very sad or unhappy. In these times, we can question how Jesus would let us be so unhappy after we have consecrated our lives to Him through His mother. Surely our unhappiness makes her sad, too!
